INITIAL INFORMATION: 03/02/2025 at 1633 hours Deputy Coroner Harris received a phone call from Coroner Sanchez to assist in the reporting of the unattended death of Kielee Rustici DOB [REDACTED]. Bonneville County Sheriff's Deputies on scene stated that the decedent's sister had gone to check on her and found her deceased in her basement bedroom. Deputies stated that the decedent was approximately 23 years old and had a history of depression, POTs syndrome, and EDS. There were no suspicious circumstances reported. The decedent's family, who share the same residence, were on scene to include the decedent's grandmother [REDACTED] and sister [REDACTED]. Coroner Sanchez and Deputy Coroner Harris gave an ETA of 25 minutes and departed toward the scene.

03/02/2025 at 1700 hours I arrived on scene and noted LE vehicles parked nearby, but did not see deputies outside of the residence so I proceeded to the front of the residence.

WEATHER: 44°

SCENE OBSERVATIONS: I observed a single story residence. I entered through the front door on the west side of the home. I entered into a living room area where family members [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were seated. There was an opening into a dining room and kitchen area. I proceeded through the dining room and kitchen and observed an opening into a laundry room on the north side of the house. I entered into the laundry room and observed an open doorway with a set of descending stairs leading to a basement. I proceeded down the stairs and observed doorways on the east and west sides of a hallway leading into storage rooms. I also observed a doorway at the north end of the hall that led to the bedroom where the decedent was found. I observed the decedent lying prone on the floor next to her bed. The room was a clutter rating of 2. I proceeded to assist Coroner Sanchez in examining the decedent (see examination below). After the examination, I placed the decedent's government issued Idaho driver's license # [REDACTED] on the decedent's chest and confirmed identification (see attached photo). I observed that there was a cell phone located on the floor near the decedent's left arm. The phone had no power and had to be charged in order to turn it on, but it was locked and no one on scene had the passcode. The room was cool but no definitive temperature could be observed. A thermostat on the bedroom wall was set to 0°. Prescription medications were located in a clear storage container on a bookcase and inside of a purse behind the bedroom door (see attached photos). Over the Counter medication and kratom were observed on top of the decedent's dresser next to her bed (see attached photos). I placed an identifying wristband on the decedent's ankle. Coroner Sanchez had determined that an autopsy was necessary to confirm cause and manner of death, so I proceeded to leave the residence to retrieve the body bag and items necessary to remove the decedent from the scene and transport her to the county morgue. I returned to the decedent's bedroom where

Coroner Sanchez and I placed the decedent into a body bag before placing a locking tag through the zippers (see attached photo). Deputies on scene assisted me in carrying the decedent out of the residence and placing her into the Coroner's vehicle.

I accompanied Coroner Sanchez back into the living room where she compassionately answered questions for the family and friends who had gathered, and we asked the final questions that we had for the family before leaving the residence and transporting the decedent to the county morgue. The decedent was placed into cold storage at the morgue.

EXAM OF DECEDENT: I observed a fully developed Caucasian female lying prone on the floor next to her bed with her head pressed up against a dresser. The decedent had brown hair and was wearing dark rimmed glasses, a blue t-shirt, and was wrapped up in a teal colored blanket from the waist down. The decedent's left and right arms were tucked underneath her chest. Lividity was consistent with the position found in and was not blanchable. I removed the blanket that was wrapped around the decedent's lower half and rolled the decedent supine. I observed that rigor was firm in the head, neck, jaw, arms, and legs. The decedent was wearing underwear but I did not observe any pants, socks or shoes. I did not observe any trauma or injury on the decedent's head, chest, abdomen, arms, or legs. I palpated the decedent's skull, neck, and shoulders and did not palpate any signs of trauma or injury. I observed that the decedent had no scarring. I did not observe any trauma or injury to the upper or lower frenulum. I did not observe any signs of petechial hemorrhaging in either the left or right eye. I placed an identifying tag #2842409, identifying wristband, and the decedent's government issued Idaho driver's license # [REDACTED] on her chest and documented them individually (see attached photos). I then placed the wristband on the decedent's ankle and ended my examination.

MEDICATIONS: medications were collected on scene by Coroner and taken to morgue for documentation and disposal.

NOK/WITNESS CONVERSATION: Konnie [REDACTED], grandmother and owner of the residence [REDACTED]: Konnie explained that the decedent had just moved into the residence about 1 month ago from Meridian due to family problems. Konnie stated that the decedent was vegan/vegetarian and she was generally very happy and active. Konnie stated that she had asked Amelia, the decedent's sister, to go and check on the decedent the day before and Amelia reported back to Konnie stating that Kielee was fine. Amelia admitted that she did not actually go to check on her sister as requested and lied about the decedent's condition. The decedent's next-of-kin will be her father, Ryan [REDACTED], and mother Tia [REDACTED] who were not present but were en route from the Twin Falls area.

RETAIN/RELEASE JURISDICTION: Due to medical history, apparent non-compliance of medical care, and circumstances present, Coroner Shante Sanchez will retain jurisdiction and will order an autopsy to confirm cause and manner of death.

INITIAL INFORMATION:

03/02/2025 at 1632 hours, I, Coroner Shante Sanchez received a phone call from Bonneville County Sheriff's Department to report the unattended death of 23 year old Kielee Rustici DOB [REDACTED] at her residence of [REDACTED]. The officer reported that the decedent had a medical history of POTs syndrome according to the family and was found wrapped in her blanket with her body prone and her face at a 90 degree angle against dresser in her bedroom as if she fainted and asphyxiated. He also reported the decedent had the substance Kratom in her vicinity including an empty 22oz bag and a third full 22oz bag. I reported an ETA of 25-30 minutes and contacted Deputy Coroner Harris to meet on scene.

03/02/2025 at 1701 hours I arrived on scene and observed multiple 8BCSO vehicles. Deputy Harris was already in home and met me outside to observe and document the scene together. We were met with 8BCSO officer who confirmed the above information and reported that the decedent was located in the basement of the residence in her bedroom.

SCENE OBSERVATIONS:

I observed a single story residence with a single garage, a front door entry facing street side and a secondary entrance B side of home. As I arrived, a fully developed male walked up from his vehicle identified as the family's bishop that was called to support the family. I allowed him to enter the home with me. I entered through the front door A side of residence and entered into a living room area. I was met with 4 fully developed adults identified as the decedent's family including the decedent's grandmother/homeowner/point-of-contact, and the decedent's sister, who also resided in the home, found the decedent, and was too distract to answer any questions. I expressed my condolences, introduced myself and the reason for my presence and explained my investigation/examination process.

I proceeded toward the C side of the residence where an 8BCSO officer was waiting. He reported that the decedent was located down the stairs in the basement in her bedroom. He explained that residence contained two cats and upon entrance into the bedroom, the officer had startled one of the cats hiding in the closet and the cat knocked over a container of soda on the dresser onto the decedent. The officer explained that the decedent had not been moved aside from the cat situation. I observed that the residence was a clutter rating of 1 and a warm temperature. I proceeded down the stairs B side of residence into the basement that was a cool/comfortable temperature. The basement was a clutter rating of 3. I proceeded down the narrow hallway and observed that the decedent's bedroom was at the end of the hallway (see attached). I observed that the bedroom contained a single bed in the B/C corner of the room. The decedent's bedroom was a clutter rating of 4. There was a built in dresser next to the closet on the A side wall. A secondary dresser was located against the B side wall and atop the dresser was multiple cans of soda, supplements and a bag of Kratom (see attached). The D side wall contained a cube storage organizer. Next to the organizer was the decedent's purse. I observed that there were tobacco vape inserts, prescription medications and the decedent's wallet with government issued Idaho driver's license # [REDACTED]. Inside the cube organizer, I observed a storage box containing multiple prescription medications. I removed the medications for cataloging and disposal (see attached). I proceeded to conduct my examination of the decedent (see examination below). After the examination with Deputy Coroner Harris, I placed the decedent's ID on her chest and confirmed identification and put an identification wristband on her right ankle. The decedent was placed in a 8BCCO body bag and secured with body bag lock #2842409. Deputy Harris and I proceeded to go speak with the decedent's family and left the residence to transport the decedent to the 8BCCO morgue/facility for storage pending autopsy at Ada County Coroner's Office.

EXAM OF DECEDENT:

I observed a fully developed Caucasian female lying prone of the floor of the bedroom next to the left side of the bed. The decedent was slender framed and had brunette hair in a pony tail and was wearing glasses. The decedent was wearing a t-shirt and a blanket was wrapped around the bottom half of her. I removed the blanket and observed that the decedent was wearing pajama shorts, no underwear, socks, or shoes. There was a yellow metal necklace around the decedent's neck. I observed a rose tattoo on her right hip area. The decedent's legs were in a crossed position (see attached). The decedent's arms were folded at the elbow and underneath the decedent's body. The decedent's face was pressed against the dresser with neck at a 90 degree angle. A cell phone was located underneath the decedent's left arm and was in the off position. I removed the phone and placed it on a charger for law enforcement. I did not observe any trauma or injury to decedent's back of head, backside, buttocks, or back of legs. Deputy Harris and I turned the decedent supine where I observed the decedent's rigor was firm and not easily breakable. Lividity was consistent and not blanchable to firm pressure. I did not palpate any trauma or injury to the decedent's head, neck or shoulders. I did not observe any trauma or injury to decedent's chest, abdomen, arms or legs. I did not observe any signs of petechia in the decedent's left or right eye. I did not observe any signs of injury to either the upper or lower frenulum in mouth. I determined that due to the decedent's age, nature of medical history, use of Kratom substance and position the decedent was found in, an autopsy would be conducted. Deputy Harris and I documented the decedent's ID on her chest, placed an identification band on her right ankle and placed her in an 8BCCO body bag secured with lock #2842409.

He thanked me for my time, I expressed my condolences once again and we ended our conversation.

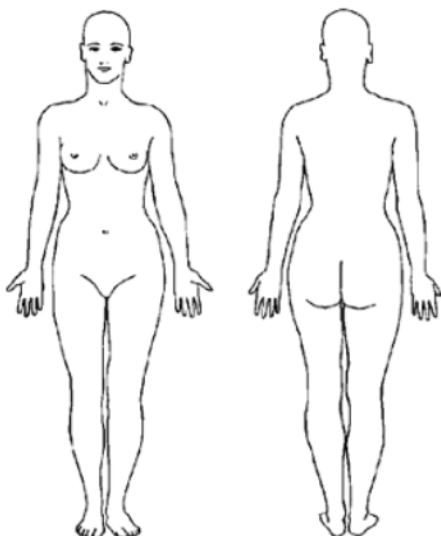

03/24/25 1405 hours - Rustici's Mother/NOK, Tia, just called. She was wondering if there were any results from her autopsy back yet. I let her know unfortunately the autopsy report may not come back for 3-6 months. I let know that the toxicology report came in and informed her of the results but let her know that how they contribute to her cause of death wont be decided until the pathologist looks it over. I did let her know that she did test positive for a few substances including Kratom and we are just waiting for the autopsy report to determine if it was a lethal level depending on her tolerance, body mass, and any findings they came in. I reassured her that as soon as the autopsy report came back that we would call her immediately and let her know.

04/10/2025 at 1253 hours I reached out to Tia Rustici to discuss the findings of the autopsy report. I did let him know that the decedent's COD has been listed as drug toxicity with a manner of death as accident. I have finalized the case and the death certificate has been signed. We discussed the substance and how the unknown effects of use could have dire implications and as a result, the substance should be removed from stores as easy access and purchasing. I informed him that he can reach out at any time to request our report, autopsy report or toxicology report for his records. She requested the records and I sent her the public request form so I could get those to her. We also arranged a time in May to meet and go over the reports when she is in town. I expressed my condolences once again and we ended our conversation.
